



Highway 99 Tunnel Program

Traffic impact: Overnight Highway 99 HOV/transit lane closures between Blundell Road and Steveston Highway

August 2024 - January 2025

Preloading of sand will soon be underway in Richmond between Blundell Road and Steveston Highway to increase southbound capacity on Highway 99. This work is part of the Highway 99 Tunnel Program focused on improving travel along the Highway 99 corridor. Once the new eight-lane tunnel is complete, Highway 99 will have three general purpose lanes and a dedicated transit lane in each direction from Westminster Highway in Richmond to Ladner Trunk Road in Delta.

- Work will occur on Highway 99 between Blundell Road and Steveston Highway from August 29, 2024 to January 31, 2025.
- This work will require closing sections of the HOV/transit lane on Highway 99 overnight.
- To minimize traffic disruptions, work will take place Monday to Friday from 10:00 p.m. to 5:00 a.m. and two southbound lanes will remain open at all times.
- Due to weather or other circumstances, there may be some weeknights when work is not scheduled.

Work will entail trucks adding preload (primarily composed of sand) on the west side of the existing HOV/transit lane to prepare the ground for widening of Highway 99, following the preload settlement period. This is a continuation of existing preload work that was done between Westminster Highway and Blundell Road.
